Reporting to a Manager, Business Applications Development, the Application Configuration Manager is responsible for analyzing, defining, configuring/developing, testing, deploying and maintaining software applications in support of the achievement of business requirements. This includes application design and prototyping in a multi-tier environment that is built primarily on Oracle technology and tools (Siebel, Oracle WebCenter, Oracle WebCenter Content, PeopleSoft HR & Payroll, APEX, PL/SQL, HTML, JAVA) and Microsoft .NET framework (Visual Basic .NET). The Application Configuration Manager will also research, design, document, and modify software specifications throughout the system life cycle. In undertaking the work, the incumbent is required to view and manipulate confidential information such as employee compensation and benefit data.

- Minimum two years experience developing in an Oracle or Microsoft environment
- Programming in SQL and Oracle PL/SQL
