ROLE SUMMARY

The Journeyman Carpenter position is a full time regular position located at our South Surrey construction site. This position reports to the Century Group Site Superintendent and works closely alongside other site team members. Century Group Carpenters are responsible for executing various scopes of work on our townhouse units. All work performed must comply within Century Group's quality standards for quality workmanship. Century Group Employees all work to ensure their work is done in a safe and timely manner.

KEY ACCOUNTABILITIES

Carpenters collaborate with other team members to construct townhomes from start to finish, including but not limited to:

- 1. Rough Carpentry: Formwork and Framing scopes of work may include building concrete and wood stairs, temporary scaffolding, guard-rails, structural framing of walls, floors, back-framing, hand cut roof joists/rafters, roof-truss installation, roof, floor, and wall sheathing. Other scopes of work may include the installation of various forms of insulation, vapour barrier & gypsum wallboard, structural steel, misc. metal connections including hardware.
- 2. Finish Carpentry: Finishing scopes of work may include the installation of doors, windows, siding, airbarriers, membrane, decks, fencing, railings, fascia & trim. In addition, this also may include interior hardwood flooring, millwork, baseboard, crown moulding, casings, cabinets, appliances and other work to support the scope of work mentioned.
- 3. CG Employees must contribute to ensuring a safe and professional work environment by maintaining both company owned and personal carpentry tools and related equipment.
- 4. May perform other related duties from time to time.
