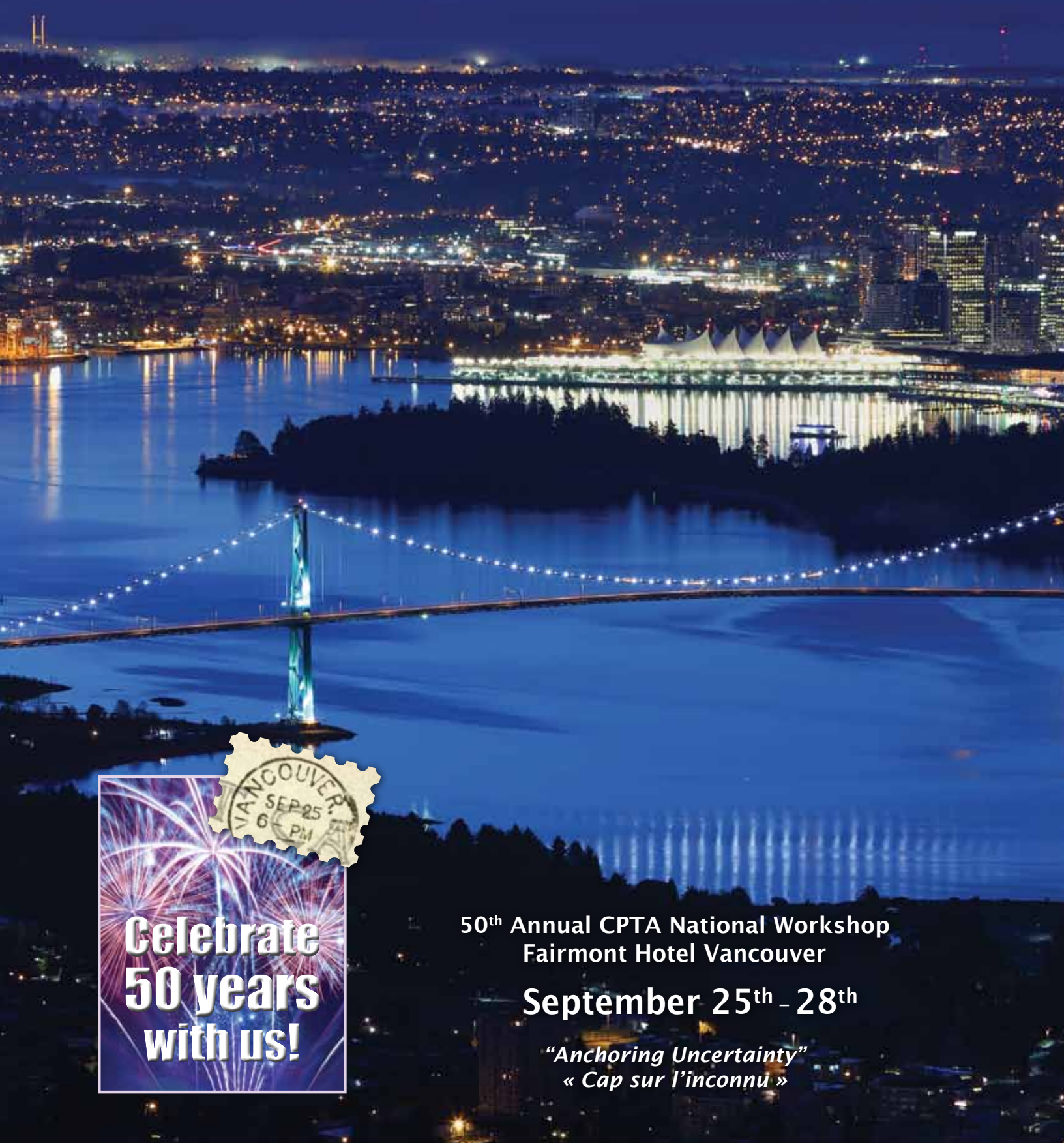

Located just minutes from downtown Vancouver and in the heart of the Pacific Spirit Park and the University Endowment Lands. In the city yet away from it all! If you are looking for a traditional west coast golf experience with majestic towering old growth trees and long narrow fairways that anyone can play, then this is it. Carved out of the pristine forests of the University Endowment Lands, the 18-hole par-72 course is a favourite among both casual golfers and regulars. Full of history (since 1929) the course today has a mature landscape which is both challenging and forgiving. It's only minutes from the city but you feel away from it all. Not to mention a clubhouse that benefits a private club. It's no wonder the University Golf Club is voted best Public Golf Course time and time again.

Come out and join us for a putting contest.

Once on the course, there will be the usual prizes for longest drive and the like, but in commemoration of the 50th Anniversary, we also will be having a special \$10,000 hole-in-one contest. This is your opportunity to get a hole-in-one, and walk away with \$10,000 in your pocket!



This year, we will be using sequential tee times (commencing at approximately 10:00 am) as opposed to a shotgun start. Once all of the registrations have been received, foursomes will be created and you will be advised of your scheduled tee time. Depending on the number of participants tee times may go as late as 12:30 pm (if we have 60 golfers). Please plan your day accordingly. Due to the sequential tee times, there will not be a group lunch following the round, but instead all participants will be invited to a private room in the clubhouse after your round where a variety of snacks will be available. This will be a great time to connect up with colleagues, enjoy some snacks and your favourite adult beverage, and relive all the wonderful shots you made on the course. The on-course prizes (longest drive, etc.) will be awarded during the conference. Come out and join us for a spectacular day of golf – including the chance to win \$10,000.
