- Work with marketing and sales teams on project branding and marketing deliverables to support sales or leasing efforts
- In coordination with the development team, develop and maintain a detailed project budget, schedule and manage execution of work; create and manage work orders, invoices, legal, and insurance documents
- Assist in executing our customer service platform, Aryze Concierge, for new homeowners.
- In coordination with the development team, collaborate on project-specific engagement and community outreach strategy
- Collaborate on socializing individual projects with community, media, mayor, and council, when applicable
