As a CARPENTER for Infinity Properties, you are responsible for various labour and carpentry tasks that contribute to the successful execution and quality completion of the project. You will approach your work with a great attitude and be proactive and accurate in your work.

#### General work to include but not be limited to the following:

- Carry out your work in accordance with WCB regulations and Infinity Properties safety program
- Report any observed hazards to your direct supervisor, the project CSO and or to the Site Superintendent
- Submit time sheets with a clear description of work to allow for the accurate allocation to the project budget
- Prep for construction by cleaning and removing obstacles
- Read and interpret drawings and sketches to determine specifications and calculate requirements
- Complete material take-offs and generate materials list
- Prep and concrete forming for sidewalks, driveways, patios and retaining walls
- Framing of exterior wood decks and stairs where required
- Back framing for units (moving walls, fixing floors, installing drops, blocking etc.)
- Installation of subfloors in units
- Install items and miscellaneous hardware as required (cabinet, bath etc.)
- Install interior and exterior doors, door hardware and windows as required.
- Assess the quality of woodwork and materials and report concerns to supervisor
- Complete deficiencies and repair work as required
- Supervise apprentices and other construction labour as required
- Assist with general clean up of the project site and the suites, through the various stages of construction
- Moving and organizing of materials and equipment on site and for in suites
- Put together and take apart temporary structures
- Install materials for the protection of work
- Assist with receiving deliveries and accurately submitting associated packing slips
- Load and unload of construction materials

- Help equipment operators and other skilled labour when necessary
- Assist trades when instructed by direct supervisor or site superintendent
- Operate and care for construction equipment as required
- Inventory of building materials or equipment as required
- Assist construction team with project planning, layout, and installation as required
